
Transportation in Quebec City

Airport Transfers

Airport transfers have been arranged for students arriving on October 28 and departing on November 7 from Québec City Jean Lesage International Airport to Hotel Universel. Upon arrival, please look out for the sign marked "Laval University".

- Operator: RTC Réseau de transport de la Capitale
- Use the Transit App to plan your trips.

You'll receive an occasional card with 8 tickets upon arrival (includes travel to BÉNÉFIQ).

Additional Tickets:

- 1. Buy with the RTC Nomade Paiement app \$3.70 per ride or \$34.00 for a 5-day pass.
- 2. Pay on board (\$4 cash, exact change only). Ask for a **transfer** if needed it allows free continuation on other routes within the validity period.

- 1. Nalk about 3 minutes to the Metrobus 807 stop.
- 2. Take the Metrobus 807 toward Pointe-de-Sainte-Foy.
- 3. Each off at Laval University (16 stops, about 16 minutes).

- To: 84 Rue Dalhousie, Quebec City, QC G1K 4C4


By bus (about 45 minutes): https://maps.app.goo.gl/KoPw9nw9vuqFP5iz7

- Malk about 1 minute to the Laval University bus stop.
- 2. Take the Metrobus 807 toward Place d'Youville.
- Get off at **H-Mercier** (13 stops, about 24 minutes).
- 4. Transfer to the RTC 11 toward Gare fluviale (Est).
- Get off at **St-Pierre** (5 stops, about 4 minutes). 5.
- Malk about 2 minutes (≈ 250 meters) to your destination. 6.

- Malk 1 minute to the M. Civilization bus stop.
- 6. Take the RTC 11 toward Pointe-de-Sainte-Foy.
- 7. Each off at **D'Youville** (6 stops, about 6 minutes).
- Malk about 3 minutes to the Metrobus 807 stop. 8.
- 9. Take the Metrobus 807 toward Pointe-de-Sainte-Foy.
- 10. E Get off at Laval University (16 stops, about 16 minutes).

- Walk about 4 minutes to Espace 400 bus stop.
- Take the RTC 11 toward Pointe-de-Sainte-Foy
- Get off at D'Youville (4 stops, about 5 minutes).
- Malk about 3 minutes to the Metrobus stop.
- Take the Metrobus 807 toward Pointe-de-Sainte-Foy.
- Get off at Laval University (16 stops, about 21 minutes).
- Malk about 1 minute (≈ 60 meters) to reach the hotel.

Bring a warm coat, hat, gloves, and closed shoes to stay comfortable outdoors.

Travel Adapter

You'll need a Type A or B adapter for Canada's plugs (120V, 60Hz). Most modern devices (110–240V) only require an adapter — a voltage converter is rarely necessary.
